Goals and activities of Helvietmed

Goals

- 1) Creation and reinforcement of professional relationships and friendship between health professionals and other fields that have a privileged relationship with Vietnam and its population.
- 2) Promotion of health(-related) and socio-educative activities in Vietnam and within Vietnamese communities abroad.

Activities

- A) Creation of the sense of solidarity and friendship between health professionals and other fields that share sympathy for Vietnam and has its development as a central goal.
- B) Collaboration with faculties of medicine and hospitals in Vietnam in the fields of education, medical research and vulgarization of medical knowledge.
- C) Creation of bounds between faculties of medicine and hospitals in Vietnam and their counterparts in Switzerland.
- D) Sponsorship of medicine students and other fields in Vietnam, who are issued of modest financial and social situations.
- E) Support socio-educative and humanitarian activities conducted by the sponsored students.
- F) Creation of Prizes to promote medical research and education in Vietnam.
